



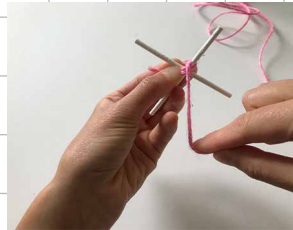

## Wrapping up

### Ojo de dios



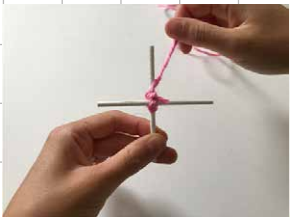
1. Hold the two sticks together in a cross shape.



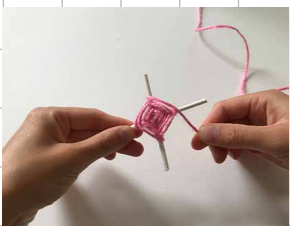
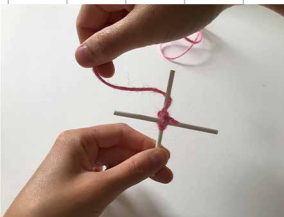
2. Secure the sticks in position by wrapping the yarn around centre point. Tie a couple of knots to secure.



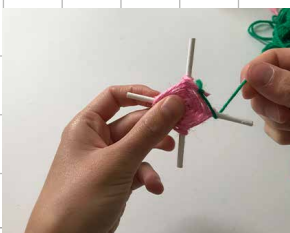
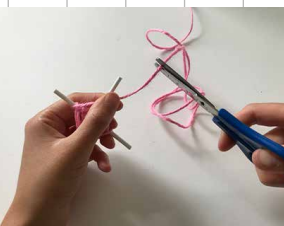
3. If you have a long tail of yarn cut it short.



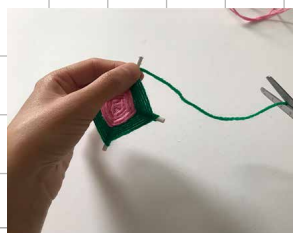
4. Wrap the yarn around each stick by bringing it over the stick, around the back and up again, then move on to the next.



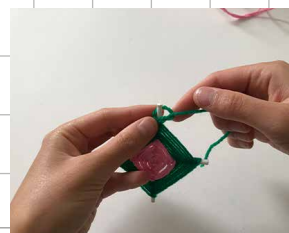
5. If you want to change your yarn, cut the yarn leaving a long length. Tie your second length of yarn to the end of your first with a secure knot and cut away the excess tails.



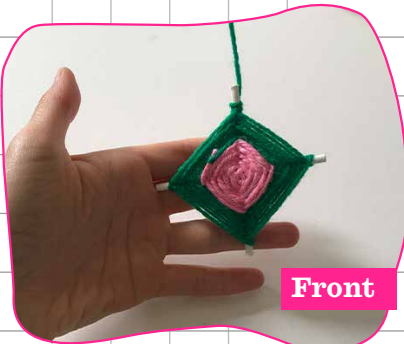
6. Continue wrapping around the sticks in the same way.



7. When you are nearly at the end of your sticks, cut the yarn and leave a long tail.



8. Tie a couple of knots around one of the sticks.

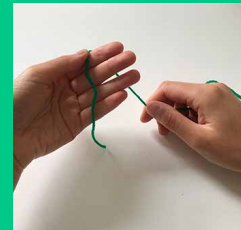

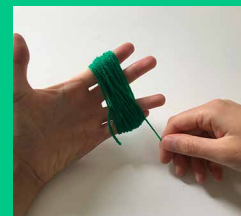
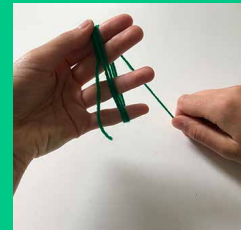

### Tassel



1. Wrap the yarn loosely around your fingers to create a loop. Keep going until you have a good tassel thickness before cutting the excess yarn. Carefully remove from your hand, keeping the shape of the yarn in a loop with a gap in the middle.



2. Cut another piece of yarn and thread through the hole. Tie a couple of tight knots. Then on the other side of the yarn circle cut all the way through the loops of yarn.



3. Cut another piece of yarn and tie a few centimetres down from the top. Tidy up the ends by cutting to the same length.
